

ABOUT RECYCLING ON UofT CAMPUS IN ANTHROPOLOGY

REDUCE

Be aware of your consumption. Purchase recyclable material. Avoid disposables. Avoid printing your e-mails... or web-pages!

REUSE

Lug a mug! to get your coffee. Many coffee shops give discounts for using refillable containers.

Bring your mug to Anthropology functions when coffee is available. When food is served, use ceramic dishes and metal cutlery when provided. We have a dish washer!



RECYCLE

MIXED PAPER — copy, binder, computer, fax and fax paper, text books, newspapers, magazines, clean paper towels, clean napkins, clean tissue, empty paper bags, Bristol board, illustration board, boxboard (i.e. tissue, cereal and snack boxes etc.)

The blue desk-side recycling containers in offices and labs are for mixed paper only (you are requested to empty your own into a nearby toter or blue box available on each floor near the elevator). **No other recyclables should be put in these blue bins.**

Note: The small black bin hooked on the side of the office blue bin is for garbage only!

PLEASE USE THE RECYCLING DEPOTS NEXT TO THE ELEVATOR OR AROUND CAMPUS FOR RECYCLING:

COFFEE CUPS

Paper coffee cups can be recycled. Please place them in their designated compartments in recycling depots. Remove lids and paper sleeves. Paper sleeves can be recycled with paper. Polystyrene lids should be removed and placed with recyclable containers.

No Styrofoam! Please place STYROFOAM with recyclable containers.

RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS including:

Cans and household plastic or glass bottles

Milk and juice cartons (flattened)

Styrofoam/polystyrene and clear clamshell containers and cups

Acceptable items include: glass, plastic, and metal food and beverage containers; aluminum trays; household, plastic bottles; clear, formed plastic i.e. cups, trays & lids, food containers; polystyrene cups, shells and lids.

Please remove excess food and liquids before depositing.

OTHER ITEMS:

PAPER TOWELS IN WASHROOMS: Receptacles in washrooms are for paper towels only which are recycled at UofT. No garbage should be placed in these receptacles.

BATTERIES- Battery recycling container in the Anthropology undergraduate lounge AP101 on the main floor.



ORGANIC/FOOD WASTE - Anthropology has green bins in the following locations:

- Ground floor lobby on west/Arch Centre side of building
- AP 102 (undergrad student lounge)
- Photocopy room (AP 254, on top of the mini fridge)
- Faculty Lounge (AP 248)
- Graduate Student Computer Room (AP 313)
- AP 246 (boardroom)
- Staff Lounge (AP 240)
- Graduate Student Lounge (AP 320)
- 4th floor hallway near elevator
- 5th floor hallway near elevator

Please **do not** put garbage, polystyrene containers or regular plastic bags in the green bins.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Please FLATTEN YOUR BOXES and place them in hallways or next to elevator.
